## A Focus on Keeping Children Safe in Education

Keeping children safe in education places the requirement to provide appropriate filtering and monitoring on schools and more guidance on what these systems should cover is provided by the UK Safer Internet Centre. Neither site however goes into any details about how the systems work and, as they are often procured by technical staff, this can lead to a misunderstanding within senior leadership as to the level of protection provided.
