The early career framework (ECF) was established by the Department for Education (DfE) to increase and improve the training and development opportunities for teachers at the beginning of their careers.

As part of the recently published ECF reforms that come into effect from September 2021, the Government is funding an entitlement for all early career teachers in England to access high-quality professional development.

This means that new teachers will now receive:



Funded development support and training over two years instead of one.



Freely available, high-quality development materials.



Funding for 5% time away in the classroom in their second year.



A dedicated mentor, and support for these mentors, including access to funded high-quality training.



Funding to cover mentors' time with the mentee in the second year of teaching.
