Supporting Teaching and Learning



Key Stage Assessment Training

In the Spring term, **142** Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 teachers attended our End of Key Stage Assessment training.

Wellbeing Toolkits

52 'Ways to Wellbeing' visits were completed to Staffordshire schools in the Spring term.

School Improvement Consultancy

In the Spring term, we delivered over **2,000** consultancy engagements to support school improvement.

Continued Professional Development

1,500 delegates attended our education technologies webinars, courses and online events in the Spring term.

6,469 Young People Supported with Careers Guidance

In 2021, Entrust supported **6,469** young people with careers information, advice, and guidance through either face to face, virtual or substantial telephone interventions.

98.5%

September Guarantee Offer Rate

The final September Guarantee Offer Rate in Staffordshire for September 2021 was **98.5%**, placing Staffordshire in Quintile One for this performance metric. This means Staffordshire is in the 30 best performing local authorities for September Guarantee.

93,034 Participants Engaged with STEM Activities

We have 604 STEM ambassadors who in the Spring term completed 992 activities through 5,763 hours involving **93,034** participants!



78 Pupils Supported with Mental Health Needs

The Primary Behaviour team have supported **78** pupils with Social Emotional and Mental Health needs in Staffordshire schools from January to May 2022.

23 Pupils Supported with English as an Additional Language

Our Minority Ethnic Achievement team have supported **23** pupils with English as an additional language/new arrivals in Staffordshire schools and delivered 8 Difference and Diversity sessions from January to May 2022.

669 Consultations for Children with SEND

Our Early Years Area SENCo team from April 2021-March 2022 completed **699** consultations for Staffordshire children identified with SEND.

Improved Ofsted Grading for Early Years Settings

Our Early Years service from April 2021 – March 2022 completed **31** visits/delivered packages of support to settings who Ofsted had graded as Requires Improvement or Inadequate. Of the five settings who have been reinspected all five have improved their Ofsted grade and are now Good.



3,267 Children Engaged in Outdoor Learning

In the first three months of this year, there have been **3,267** children and young people who've visited our outdoor centres. That's an increase of 1072 (49%) from the same period in 2019 before the pandemic, showing a real bounce back for the sector and recognition of the value of outdoor learning to schools.

DofE Award Back in Full Swing

The Duke of Edinburgh's Award expeditions recommenced in full again from March, the first time since the start of the pandemic.

Whole Class Ensemble Teaching

Over **5,000** children will participate each week in the Whole Class Ensemble Teaching programme through 2022/23.

Regular Music Groups in the Community

700 children have returned to regular music groups run by the Music Service across Staffordshire in the evenings and weekends.

Individual Music Lessons

Over **10,000** young people have a music lesson each week provided by the Music Service.

Quality Music Education for 75 Years

Our Music Service is **75 Years** old this year and has supported tens of thousands of children with their entitlement to a quality music education since 1947.

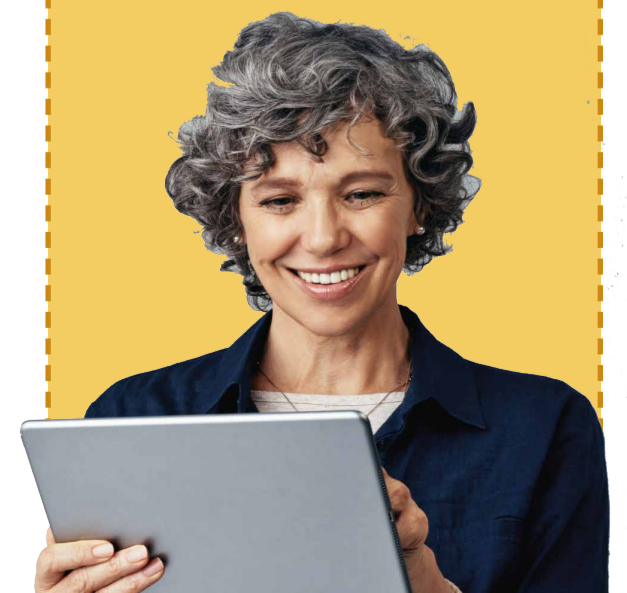
School Training & Partnerships

We clerked **509** Governor meetings during the Spring term.

We delivered over **9,000** hours of School Resource Management training from December 2021 to April 2022.

We successfully dealt with Over **10,000** incidents that were raised with the Education Technologies Service Desk in Spring 2022.

39 New Governors Trained

We delivered induction training to **39** new Governors during the Spring term.

2 New Apprentices

We have recently appointed **2** apprentices – a Payroll & Bacs apprentice and a schools finance apprentice.

650 Hardware Repairs

In Spring 2022, we made over **650** hardware repairs, including over 200 iPads (which would otherwise have been completely replaced).

29 Pension Scheme Returns

In the Spring term, we completed **29** Local Government Pension Scheme (LGPS) returns covering approx 15,000 employees.



2,500 Technician Support Days

We delivered over **2,500** on-site technical support days in Spring 2022.

Over 70 Infrastructure Upgrades

Over **70** school technology infrastructure upgrade projects completed in Spring 2022.

15,000 Surface Pros Delivered

We have delivered **15,000** Microsoft Surface Pros to teaching staff in Northern Ireland in the first 4 months of the project. We have 5,000 to go and the project will be complete ahead of schedule!

9,000 Hours of School Resource Management Training

We have delivered over **9,000** hours of School Resource Management training.

End of Year Certificates for Teachers Populated

In the Spring term, **122** End of Year Certificates for teachers were automatically populated for all our academies/trusts to provide assurance to the Secretary of State that all contributions have been correctly paid over to the Teachers' Pension Scheme.

Urgent Condition Repairs

From April 2021-March 2022, we helped to rectify **687** urgent D1 condition repairs in schools and academies during the last year enabling them to maintain a safe environment for their pupils and staff.



Asbestos Removal

From April 2021-March 2022, we safely managed **10,438** pieces of Asbestos Containing Materials in schools and academies during the last year enabling them to maintain a safe environment for their pupils and staff.



Condition Surveys

From April 2021-March 2022, we carried out Condition Surveys on **154,127 m²** of School and Academy buildings during the last year informing their ongoing Asset Management plans.



Digital CAD Floor Plans

From April 2021-March 2022, we produced digital CAD floor plans for **75,049m²** m2 of school and academy buildings during the last year informing their ongoing Asset Management plans.



Decarbonisation

From April 2021-March 2022, we managed decarbonisation projects aiming to remove 800 tonnes of carbon from our environment every year providing a greener region.
