





OAEP Educational Visits Co-ordinator Training Course (EVC)

The course is provided by the Outdoor Education Adviser's Panel and delivered by the Entrust EVA's, who are OEAP Course directors, and will follow OEAP guidelines and core messages. It will give an overall insight into the benefits of Learning Outside the Classroom experiences including curriculum based visits, adventurous activities, residential and overseas visits. The attendees will be shown how and where to access guidance and be given examples of good practice. This will include information on formulating school and academy policies and procedures including legal requirements, visit planning, use of providers, assessing competency of staff, risk benefit assessments, monitoring visits and evaluating outcomes. It is aimed at people who have been assigned the role of EVC at their establishment but is also a useful course for heads of establishments who are responsible for approving visits. Attendees should have experience of delivering or assisting with educational visits although this is not essential. If an attendee does not have this experience, it is advised that they have a colleague back at their establishment who does has extensive visit experience and can assist the EVC with their role.
